





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



### SysLoc®MINI Diagram

Leave a small amount of the needle visible to prevent oozing.

Inserting too far will cause the tissue to spread and may cause unnecessary oozing.





### Preparing for removal


- Keep last piece of tape in place until external lock is unlocked.
  - This will maintain needle stability and prevent unnecessary discomfort to the patient.








### Needle Removal: Unlocking the external LOCK





1: Place thumb on external notch

2: Place index finger on external locking mechanism



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#### **Needle Removal:**

### Unlocking the external LOCK - Cont.





**3:** Using your thumb and index fingers, unsnap external lock

4: Move external lock out of your way




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#### **Needle Removal:**

### Unlocking the external LOCK - Cont.





5: Remove last piece of tape




6: Prepare for retraction place thumb and middle finger on the clear plastic tubing directly behind the external lock. Use fatty portion of index finger rather than nail for better control.

### Unlocking the external LOCK - Cont.





7: Start retraction by pushing index finger forward while simultaneously pulling back with thumb and middle finger.

8: To ensure complete retraction has been achieved continue to pull straight back until audible click is heard.

\*TIP: you may find that applying a slight amount of downward pressure facilitates complete retraction.
